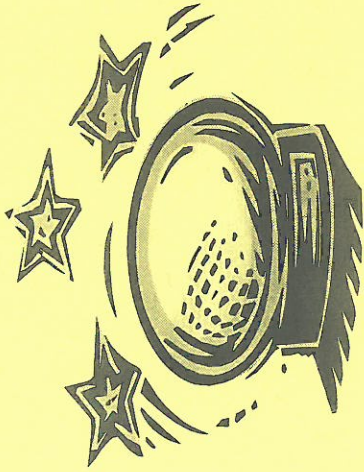


You are the Predictor

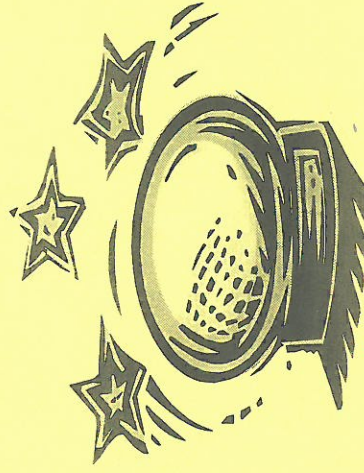


Your role is to make **3-4 predictions:**

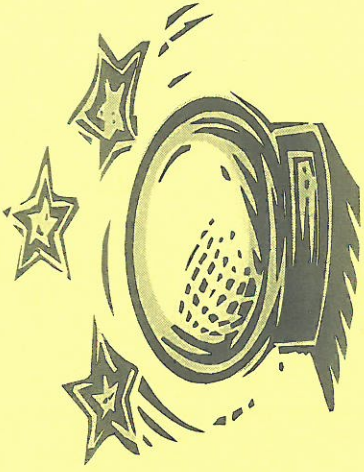
